A District Building and Safety Engineering Associate is responsible for performing a combination of the following essential job functions: assists in the administration and technical direction of the activities of Inspectors, Permit Technicians and clerical personnel; supervises the issuance of building permits and the collection of related fees; supervises inspectors engaged in the checking of construction plans and specifications and in the performance of field inspections of building construction and electrical, mechanical and plumbing installations; performs field inspections on unusual cases or those which pose public relations concerns; confers with owners, architects and engineers regarding structural features, designs and construction, and provides information relating to code or ordinance requirements; investigates complaints and resolves issues between builders and inspectors involving code or ordinance interpretation; supervises inspection personnel performing field inspections of buildings requiring rehabilitation or demolition, identifying property owners, preparing estimates for demolition and advising property owners regarding provisions of the Property Rehabilitation demolition program; files complaints against willful violators of the County's Building Laws and testifies in court if necessary; cooperates with other departments and agencies in the enforcement of building, electrical, mechanical and plumbing codes or zoning ordinances; coordinates inspection and related activities with officials of contract cities; and drives a motor vehicle to get to various inspection sites on a routine basis.
